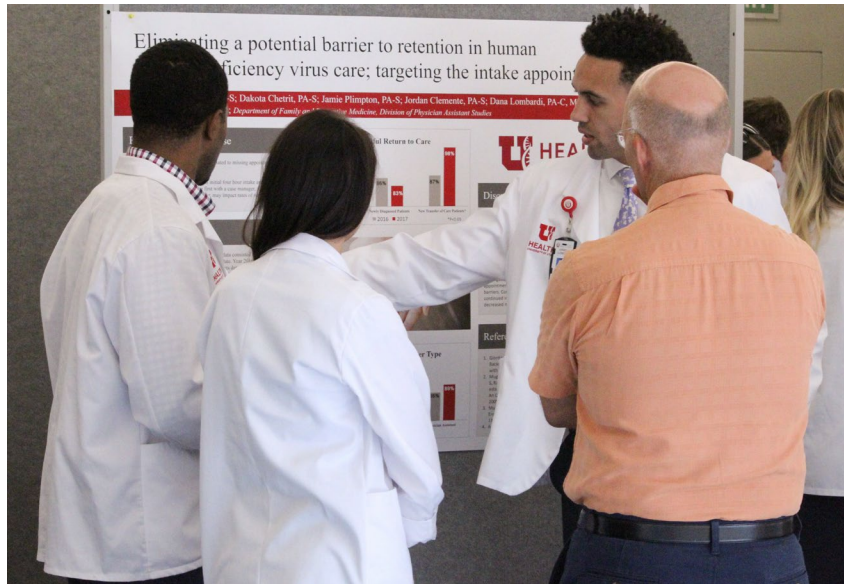


# Education, Research, and Community Engagement Summit
